

NEIGHBOUR NOTICE

Balfour Beatty is currently constructing the A9/A85 Junction Improvement and Link Road to Bertha Park on behalf of the Council. This project includes construction of a new A9 junction with slip roads, a new link road to Bertha Park and a new junction on the A85.

In order to undertake preparatory works associated with the construction of the new bridge over the River Almond (as shown on the map below) it will be necessary to extend the site working hours on the weekends of 10/11; 17/18 and 24/25 June 2017.
